

Not automatically conveyable parcels (NC)



A parcel is classed as not automatically conveyable if it cannot be sorted via the DPD conveyor systems due to its shape or dimensions. A surcharge may be imposed for these parcels due to the special handling which is required. This overview provides you with details of parcels that are not automatically conveyable.

Automatically conveyable parcels

Weights/dimensions	
Length:	≤ 120 cm
Width:	≤ 60 cm
Height:	≤ 60 cm
Girth:	< 300 cm
Weight:	31,5 kg

Not automatically conveyable parcels

Dimensions	Volume	Excess size, weight or length
Length: 121–175 cm	> 150 litres	Length: 175–250 cm
Width: > 60 cm		Girth: 300–330 cm
Height: > 60 cm		Weight: > 31,5 kg

Girth and volume calculator:

Girth: $2 \times \text{Height [cm]} + 2 \times \text{Width [cm]} + \text{longest side [cm]}$

Volume: $\text{Length a [cm]} \times \text{Length b [cm]} \times \text{Length c [cm]} / 1000$

Parcels which are **not automatically conveyable** due to their shape:



Canisters



Buckets/drums



Roll-shaped packages



Wooden or metal packages



Goods in sacks or bags



Unpackaged special shapes
